DEFINITIONS

GLORIOUS

Exhibiting attributes, qualities or acts that are noble, praiseworthy, excellent inspiring admiration and respect. Blessed

SINGLE

A state where an individual of marriageable age is yet to marry or remains unmarried and has no sexual companion. (Temporal or permanent)

CLASSES OF SINGLES

- Bachelor/Spinster expecting to marry in future whether definite or indefinite.
- Celibate one abstaining from marriage and sexual relationship because of religious vow. Also called Eunuch.
- Eunuch see Celibate above. Also one castrated for political/military service.

CAUSES OF SINGLENESS

- 1. Early step into marriageable age put as 18 under Nigerian law.
 - 2. Delibrate decision to determine when to marry.
 - 3. Delays in expectation for marriage.
 - 4. Divorce.
 - 5. Death of spouse/decision not to remarry
 - 6. Faith commitment (vow)-MATT.19:12
 - 7. Political/Military reason ISA. 39:7

- (a). Freedom to serve God-1COR. 7:32
- (b). Freedom to build career.
- (c). Freedom to give love and care as well as companionship to parents.

2. OPPORTUNITY TO:

- (a). Focus on character building.
- (b). Develop a vision for life.
- (c). Develop & understand relationship.
- → (d). Build financial strength.
- → (e). Evaluate lifestyle and relationship.
- (f). Volunteer for missions.

CHALLENGES OF SINGLENESS

LONELINESS-

- (a) remember that God is always with you GEN. 28:15; MATT. 28:20; JN. 14:17.
- (b). Be seriously involved with the Church family for love communion.
- (c). Develop a ring of friends who share faith values with you.
- (d). Be actively involved in career, missions, and other volunteer works.

FINANCIAL CHALLENGES

- (a). Always plan within your means.
- (b). Exercise strict financial discipline that makes for independence.
- (c). Create other sources of income.



SEXUAL INCONTINENCE –

- → (a). Understand that your body is the temple of the LORD and not for sin 1 COR. 3:16-17, 6:19.
- (b). Flee from sexual immorality -1 COR. 6:18.
- (c). Be determined to put your body under control else even after marriage you will still fall into immorality.
 - (d). Strictly avoid pornography and any relationship that is prone to the temptation of sexual sin.
- → (e). Take time to pray and meditate on the Word of God.

NEGATIVE ATTITUDE FROM PEOPLE (PARENTS & OTHERS) - Remember that:

- (a). You live for God not men.
- (b). When it is the right time you will marry, don't be in a hurry ECCL. 3:11; ISA. 28:16.
- (c). You are not to follow the counsel of the ungodly PSA. 1:1-3.



→ 5. LOW SELF ESTEEM

- (a). The LORD say you shall not be ashamed-ISA. 54:4-8; PSA. 139:14
- (b). Find joy in the LORD PHIL. 4:4.
- (c). Boldly manifest other glories in you as you honourably serve the community.
- (d). Find peace in the grace and forgiveness in Christ Jesus.
